Lunchtime issues	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Children shouting across the tables</li> <li>Some people are messing around with the cups before getting their lunch – blowing in them and spinning them.</li> </ul>	<p>MDS notes down the names of anyone shouting across the hall. Each time a pupil's name is noted, they lose 1 minute of that day's lunchbreak.</p> <p>No cups on the table to begin with. Once the whole table has lined up for their lunch, the MDS can put a stack of 10 cups on the empty table. <i>LW to put this change to MDS.</i></p>
Playground issues	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Some children teasing others when the ball has been kicked over the wall.</li> <li>Ball games are being played in the whole of the playground with no room for anyone else.</li> <li>Goal posts needed.</li> </ul>	<p>Children who are teasing others will be asked to leave the football playing area for that day.</p> <p>Bottom third of the playground for football only. Middle section of the playground is for small ball games such as ball shooter, tennis – no 'hit the wall' or dodgeball to be played during lunch break – these can be played at last break when it is KS2 only out in the playground. Top section of the playground and the side of Class 2 is a no ball zone.</p> <p>LW to look into purchasing some goal posts.</p>
Award system	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Reading award: would people read more if they got golden tickets/housepoints for using the bookmark questions?</li> </ul>	<p>All classes agreed that they would read more if they got golden tickets or housepoints for reading at home as well as getting stickers for a reading token.</p>
Clubs	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>How can we get more pupils to attend clubs?</li> </ul>	<p>Some people cannot attend ASC due to other clubs such as swimming, brownies etc.</p> <p>Y6 suggested running a lunchtime club once a week (perhaps a Thursday) where 3 Y6s would organise and run a club once a week – this would mean that each Y6 would be giving up half an hour of their time, once a month.</p>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• What clubs would you like?</li></ul>	<p>It was suggested that a slip was displayed on the pupil voice board with the details of that Thursday's club, which Y6s were running the club and a sign up sheet (no more than 10 pupils)</p> <p>ASC ideas – computing, rollerskating, running, team challenges, drama, karaoke, chillax, movie, kiddicoding, baking, den-building, treasure hunt, rugby, dance, craft club and outdoor games.</p> <p>Lunchtime club ideas: drawing, dance, computers, movie, chillax, construction, craft, singing, Makaton, painting, book club, magic club, spy club.</p>
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
