



# Online Safety at Crosby

## At Crosby we...

Protect your children from viewing anything harmful on the Internet; *as much as we reasonably can.*



## We do this by....

- Applying School Safe filters to our network and Internet Searches.
- Sadly, this does not completely eradicate all inappropriate material: online perpetrators' are becoming more and more savvy at avoiding filters. We maintain the upmost vigilance in policing this in school.

Prepare our children so that they know what to do if they were to see anything harmful.



- Reminding them to tell an adult and NOT click on something inappropriate.
- Showing them how to minimise a window if they were to see something inappropriate on screen; before they then tell an adult.
- Teaching them how to report something that they experience: either on the website (e.g. Youtube) or by using the CEOP report button which can be found on our school website (KS2 children)

Develop our children into responsible Internet users so that they are less likely to experience harmful material



- Teaching them how to search the Internet safely. They use search terms such as 'for kids' at the end of their searches, use advanced searches, use search shortcuts.
- Encouraging them to judge what is appropriate content for their age group, and what is not.
- Celebrating when children have acted responsibly so that they can be role models for the rest of the school.
