Create a Holiday brochure for a visit to Egypt.	Build a pyramid out of any Material that you have available.	Research mummification and explain the process.	Create an Egyptian landscape drawing which includes the pyramids.
Find out about Ancient Egyptian recipes (try to cook something if you think it is possible).	Investigate the climate in Egypt and share what you would pack in your suitcase.	Write a poem which includes descriptions of Egypt. Think about the weather, landscapes and what you can do there.	Design an outfit for a rich and a poor Ancient Egyptian person.
Make an entertainment guide (similar to a TV guide in the modern day) for an Ancient Egyptian.	Find or write a story which tells us about the 'afterlife' (something the Ancient Egyptians strongly believed in).	Draw a plan of a rich persons house. How many rooms would they have had and what were they used for?	Mummify an object or old toy. Bring in a photo or the object, if possible.
Make a model of an Ancient Egyptian home.	Make a fact file for a famous Pharaoh .	Tell us about Tutankhamun...	Create the Ancient Egyptian Timeline.
