Create a fact file about a European country.	Make a 3D model of a famous European Landmark.	Research the major rivers within Europe.
	Create a poster to advertise a visit to a European city that you might see in a Tourist Information Centre.	Write a diary entry of a school day in another European country. Find out about how their school may differ from ours.	Design your own flag for a chosen European country and annotate to explain the design.
Find out about which European countries have won The European Cup. Compile a fact file showing this information.	Produce a menu with a starter, main meal and dessert for three different European countries to show traditional foods of each country.	Find out about famous European landmarks and locate on a map of Europe.	Create a language dictionary with foreign words commonly used words, e.g. hello, goodbye and thanks etc.
Discover how other European countries celebrate Christmas.	Design and compile a cookbook showing cuisines of different countries around Europe.	Research information about ten different capital cities in Europe and show location of each on a map.	Find out about traditional dress of five different European countries.
