Wishing you a Happy New Year and welcome back to the Spring term.

Sadly I was unable to run the open session for Reception children last term due to illness. I would not like to let our children (or yourselves) down and so I invite the parents of our **Reception** children to come and join us for an **Open Afternoon Session** on **Thursday 17th January 2019**. You will have the chance to look at your child's file, they can show you around the classroom, and you will also be able to take part in some Science activities with your child to kick start our new 'Finding out' topic. You may arrive at school from **2.30pm onwards**; taking your child (and siblings) when you have finished. If you are unable to attend, your child will still be able to take part in the activities and if you wish to see their file then simply ask one night after school.

To encourage healthy living and lower carbon emissions, we are running our Feet First walking scheme this term. If your child walks to school at least once a week, they can monitor it on our wall chart and will be awarded with a badge at the end of the term. Please join us in this positive scheme; even if it's simply from the village hall.

To support our new topic we will be having an exciting visit from 'The Science Booth' workshop on **Monday 21st January 2019**. The 'Scientist' will be leading some hands on activities for the children to test out. This will be for all Reception and Nursery children who attend school on this day. We are asking for a voluntary contribution of £2.50 towards the cost of this visit.

I am also on the hunt for any relatives or friends of your families who might be able to come and speak to our children about something in the past which has happened to them; something memorable or a great achievement in history perhaps. I would love to give the children an opportunity to 'find out' about something which has happened to someone in our community, ask some questions, and widen their life experiences.
